# Admission Eligibility

Any person who has earned a high school diploma or equivalent - such as a certificate of proficiency issued by the State Board of Education including a General Education Department (GED) - is eligible for admission to More Life College. Non-high school graduates 18 years of age or older who demonstrate ability to profit from a community college education may also be admitted.

There are four main types of students who attend More Life College.

## First Time College Students

First time college students are individuals who are a high school graduate or at least 18 years old and never attended any college (other than those who attended while in high school)

### **Continuing Students**

Continuing students are individuals who attended classes at any Community College.

## Special Admit Students (Dual Enrollment)

High school students who will have started ninth grade or be at least 14 years of age by the start of classes and adult school students working on a high school diploma program maybe eligible to enroll in a maximum os eleven units of More Life College classes each semester through Dual Enrollment program.

## Dual Enrollment Admission

Courses that provide enrichment and advancement in educational experience may be offered to high school and adult school students. The student must have started ninth grade or be at least 14 years old by the first day of school.

High school students should request information from their high school counselor regarding eligibility and complete the special Admit Form that has been signed by parent and by the high school counselor or principal, and an official transcript. Fees

<u>Fee Payment Deadlines</u>

Tuition and fees are due soon after you enroll in classes. You maybe dropped if your fees are not paid by the fee payment deadline. This is true even if you enroll in a class that starts late in the semester.

Fall Semester- August Spring Semester- January

## <u>Financial Aid</u>

Not all your financial aid awards are automatically applied to your fee )California College Promise Grant is an example of financial aid that is automatically applied). After you have applied your financial aid, you are responsible for paying the remaining amount on your account.

Make sure you apply for financial aid as early as possible and review the all financial aid deadlines.

## How to Pay for Classes

Pay your tuition and fees using any of the following methods:

- 1. Online through eServices with a credit card
- 2. By mailing with a check
- Make checks payable to More Life College
- Mail your check to the Business Office
- Make sure to include your student ID number and "enrollment fees" on the check's subject line.
- 3. In Person
- 4. Using the student payment plan
- Pay your fees over a few months instead of all at once. There is a non-refundable \$15 fee each semester you use the student payment plan.

# How Much Does College Cost?

The Cost of Attendance (sometimes called COA) refers to the average amount a full-time student can expect to spend while enrolled at More Life College over a nine-month period. Students may not for see all of the expenses involved in attending college, and exact cost depends on factors such as housing status and residency.

#### Financial Aid Disbursement Calendar

All aid is disbursed weekly thereafter as you become eligible for disbursement.

A change in enrollment or increase in aid eligibility may cause an over award, which will stop future disbursements until resolved. Over award may result in students having to repay funds in excess of eligibility.

# Receive Your Aid/Aid Refund

To ensure you receive your financial aid, make sure to monitor activity in your eServices and More Life College account, including the following:

- Clear all Financial Aid holds listed in the "Holds" section.
- Submit all "Required " and "Assigned" To Do List Items promptly
- Understand unit requirements in relationship to your award type and amount.
- Check your eligibility in your eService

#### Refunds

Outstanding fees are deducted from financial aid before calculating a refund.

Refund are delivered after disbursement using BankMobile. Be sure to set your BankMobile preference. There are two methods by which your financial aid refund is delivered:

### Refund Method 1: Checks

Students under 16 and/or students who are undocumented will receive a paper check from More Life College. Checks are usually mailed approximately two weeks after your disbursement and are mailed to the address you have on record with the Admissions and Records Office.

Refund Method 2: Bank Mobile Disbursements More Life College delivers your refund with BankMobile Disbursement, a technology solution powered by BMTX, Inc.

#### Pell Grant

Pell Grant award year and thereafter , a student's scheduled Pell Grant Award is multiplied by the student's enrollment intensity percentage to determinge the Annual Pell Grant Award.

At this time, the update to Enrollment Intensity only applies to the Federal Pell Grant. Other forms of aid will continue to be awarded based on Enrollment Category (full-time, three quarter time, half-time and less than half-time.

Cal Grant and Student Success Completion Grant

Funds for these types of aid require students to be enrolled in at least six (6) units of financial aid-eligible classes.

Cal Grant and Student Success Completion Grant disbursements are based upon the number of units students are enrolled in on the Cal Grant Recalculation date or Cal Grant disbursement date. This means that if a student becomes eligible for Cal Grant after the recalculation date and has dropped classes, we will only pay for the classes the student is still enrolled in when we disburse aid.

• Follow the schedule for Pell Grant

federal Supplement Education Opportunity Grant (FSEOG) and Federal Direct Student Loan Requirements

To Receive an FSEOG or federal direct loan, students must be enrolled at least 6 units of financial aid eligible classes. For direct loans, if a student is enrolled in a single semester and it is their final semester, then they can request their direct loan be prorated based on the total units enrolled and remaining eligibility. # Free Federal Student Aid

The free application for Federal Student Aid is a form for US Citizens, permanent residents, or eligible non-citizens to get financial aid, Financial Aid includes fee waivers, grants, work-study, loans and scholarships. Submits the FASFA each year you are in college- only takes about 30 minutes to complete when you are prepared.
